

WELCOME TO THE DEMO VERSION OF DJPOWER

The DJPower program is specifically designed for DJ's, KJ's, nightclubs and radio stations and has been created with the help of professional Disc Jockeys from around the world. DJPower provides you with multiple capabilities, without a need for added equipment or software. You can program your entire evening, save it for future use with or without modifications and find those last minute requests with ease.

DJPower is a full encompassing program to meet all the needs of a modern and professional DJ. Due to the fact that this is a demo version, **not all aspects of the program are fully available to you**. Even though some aspects are not fully functional, you will still be able to explore their windows.

If you do not already have mp3 files, you will have to download some mp3 songs from the internet (or other source) to try out DJPower. Make sure you've downloaded them before installing the DJPower demo, as DJPower will scan your hard drive to find your songs....

IMPORTANT: This demo version will allow you to work with it **a total of thirty times** before it shuts down completely. The program will allow each of the thirty times to last *a maximum of one hour*. We hope this will allow you ample time to try the various features of the program.

DJPOWER DEMO IN BRIEF

Now we will give you a brief introduction of what you can do through DJPower by describing the main screen. (The exact screen layout may differ slightly to that on our web site or brochure depending on the size and/or resolution of your screen, whether or not you are maximizing the window, and which version you are demo-ing.)

NOTE: By no means does the information in this document try to explain every aspect of the DJPower program. This information is to provide you a quick overview of parts of the program, so that you may feel more comfortable while you use this demo version

DJPower has a screen that you can customize to your own needs. It includes every thing that you will need to run your event worry free.

If there are any actions taken in the computer while music is playing, such as opening another program or using other features within DJPower, the music **will not be effected**. This feature is unique to DJPower, and is because of new developments in technology that have exceptional abilities.

DJPower follows Windows™ standards and uses the "drag and drop" method, which is very comfortable and easy to use. (If you are unfamiliar with this method, look up "drag and drop" in the Help Index of your Windows™ program). You can drag the songs from any area on the screen to any other area that you want. You will use the "drag and drop" method for almost any operation, such as to add and to cancel songs, to rearrange the existing play list, to perform express recording, to play, erase, copy, and transfer songs and special effects. While "dragging and

dropping" the cursor will change to:



If you try to "drop" in an inappropriate area, the cursor will change to a "no entry" sign: **⊘**.

Most screen areas and buttons have custom menus that can be accessed by using the right click on the mouse. These menus can be used to perform specific operations, or as shortcuts.

The main DJPower screen is built of three main parts. The right-hand side is to show you, and to allow you to choose, the songs that are in your computer. The center of the screen allows you to follow along with the songs that are to be played, and have been played. The left-hand side is the DJPower control center.

On the bottom of the screen are a variety of buttons that are action icons. These buttons allow you to access many more features within DJPower. Each button has a picture to help depict its use. For example, the Menu button has an



icon picturing a utility knife and will open the DJPower Menu.

On the far right of the main screen, there are more pictorial buttons in a column. These buttons are really shortcuts to folders/directories. These allow you to access your songs quickly, and to easily transfer a list of songs to the to play list. For example, clicking on the Oldies button will bring up the songs stored there, and will list all those songs on the songs list. From the songs list, you can select all the songs that you want to play. With the right click of your mouse, you can change and customize the shortcuts. DJPower provides an unlimited amount of fully customizable, shortcut buttons. By using the "drag & drop" method you can change the order of the shortcuts. To create new shortcuts, simply click on the browse button at the top of the list, to choose your directory.

On the right side of the screen is the *songs list(s)*. From here you will be able to drag and drop your songs to the *songs to play list*, and other locations on the screen. With the option of having this information in two or even three locations on the screen, you have the flexibility of accessing two folders at the same time and to copy or move files between directories by using the "drag and drop" method.. The song titles can change colors, depending on what you've chosen in the Options menu, alerting you that you have already played the song, or that it is already in the play list.

At the top right-hand side of the screen, next to the folder buttons, you will find a box of *hot buttons*, that allow a quick approach to sound effects. These buttons can be programmed with songs, special effects or even announcements you record yourself. These sounds can be played one time or

continuously, depending on the option you choose. The corresponding slider buttons at the bottom of the box adjust the volume and pitch of the selections.



The buttons that are on the list, allow you to control the songs, similar to a standard player. A "talk" control pause the music by fading it out and fading it back in.

DJPower also has a **single song play** window that allows editing and if you have two sound cards, allows you to listen to two songs simultaneously. This feature also allows for **manual beat mixing** if you have two sound cards.





On the far left of the screen is the DJPower *control panel*. The panel includes column and pitch control with the ease of a scroll bar, or the click of your mouse. There are two volume controls, one for the music and one for the plugged in microphone (if you are using one). The panel also has a mixer control that allows you to choose the length of the mix and the type of mix you want. For convenience the mixer includes six preset positions located on either side of the mixer. In addition, the control panel has various indicators and clocks. Clicking on the blue progress bar will “rewind” or “fast forward” the song.

DJPower remembers the songs that have been played and represents them in a calendar style window that depicts when they have recently been played.



With the click of this button, you are able to access the information window. Here, you are able to store information on individual songs, such as the year, the singer, the speed, etc. With this information, DJPower allows you to search for all the songs that have a common theme. With the click of a button you are able to pull up information on any song, view it or print it. This will include the song name, the location on your hard drive, the type of song it is, the length of the song, and information that you have entered such as the year, the artist, the speed, etc. This pop-up window is also capable of saving parameters of each song, such as volume, pitch, delay time, bass & treble



The Recording Studio (though not fully functional in this demo version) allows you to record from your internal CD-ROM as well as an external source, such as a tape deck, turntable or CD player. Preset options are available, or you are able to choose the various options such as the CD recording method, the recording source, the CD interface, the post-compression rate, etc. The recording Studio is simplistic in that it allows you to record and compress with the click on one button. This frees your time while the most time consuming part of the recording occurs.




The DJPower program combines very powerful compression technologies that allow you a compression ratio of 1:10 for stereo or 1:25 for mono, and more. (Compression not fully


functional in this demo version) DJPower will give you this high compression rate of songs without compromising or diminishing the quality of the sound. (This is done by eliminating the frequencies that our ears cannot hear). This kind of compression allows you the ability to store on your hard drive all that you need for many hours of music.

Many of the functions on the main screen can be accessed through the function keys. Press the "F1" key on your keyboard and you can see, the function keys allow you to quickly access some of the most often used applications in the program.

We at DJPower International LLC thank you for trying the demo version of our product. When you start using the program on a regular basis, you will see that the efficiency and the variety of functions will make your life as a DJ very easy, comfortable, and virtually stress free.

QUICK HELP

To **Play** a song in the play list: click 

To **Skip** to the next song: click 

To **Restart** a song: click 

To **Move** a song in the play list: drag and drop

To change **Volume** or **Pitch**: click and drag

To **Manually Mix**: 1) "Mix" must be black, if not, click on "Mix".

2) Click and drag slider under the play list to left or right




To **Auto Mix**:

1) "Mix" must be green, if not, click on "Mix".

2) Choose length of mix and configuration



To insert a **Stop** command between songs: click on  To resume play, click on



To **Zoom into a song** in the songs list: click on any song on the list and start typing the name of the desired song. Your desired song can be found with as little as one letter.
